CTIS organised the first Mandarin Conference cum Workshop on Theology of the Body

The Chinese Department of CTIS organised a Mandarin Conference cum workshop on the Theology of the Body from 27th to 29th May 2016. The 3-day programme attracted a strong turnout of over 70 participants. Apart from students of CTIS, many lay Catholic parishioners, several religious and non-Catholics attended the workshop. The Institute was honoured to host Dr. Bosco Ning, a lecturer in Moral Theology from the Fu Jen Faculty of Theology of St Robert Bellarmine, Taipei, as the guest speaker.



In his welcome address, Fr. Peter Zhang, the Vice-Rector of CTIS, extended a warm welcome to the guest speaker and to all participants. Fr. Zhang mentioned that while there are many English-language resources and conferences on Pope Saint John Paul II's groundbreaking "Theology of the Body", similar materials and talks in Chinese are a rarity here. This workshop has fulfilled the long awaited needs of some of the Mandarin speaking faithful.

Over the course of three days, Dr. Ning expounded on the key themes of Pope Saint John Paul II's seminal work "Theology of the Body" – a compilation of a series of 129 lectures delivered by the Pope during his Wednesday

audiences – including the bodily dimension of human personhood, the gift of sexuality, marriage and family life, and responsible parenthood, to name but a few topics.

The participants benefitted greatly from this intense and thought-provoking workshop. Jude Koh, a married participant, commented that the three day workshop had a very well-balanced programme with an excellent presenter in Dr Ning. "The workshop helped us to develop a healthy in-depth understanding of oneself", he added.

For CTIS student Richard Lee, the workshop gave him a "fresh perspective and insight" into the fundamental dignity and significance of the human body, and in particular, "how a person co-operates with God to play a positive role in God's plan of creation and completes the cycle of Love."




卓蒂娜:
